

Action Sheets for Bank Clients

Sample Conversation: Bank Transactions

A = Bank Teller B=Customer

A: Good Afternoon. How may I help you today?

B: Hi. I'd like to cash this check.
deposit this money into my account
withdraw \$500.00 from my account.
change this into American money.
pay this bill.

A: Can I have your bankcard please?

B: Ok. Here you are.

A: And, I'll need some picture ID as well.

B: Is my driver license OK?
passport

A: That'll be fine. Thanks.
 ...Teller counts money/writes a receipt...

A: Here is your ID and here is your money.
your receipt

A: Will there be anything else for you today?

B: No, that's all thank you.

A: Have a nice day.

B: You too.
